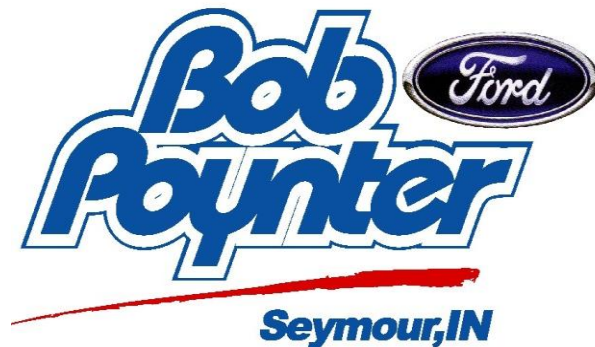

Recipe Corner

STRAWBERRY LIMEADE

2 lb. strawberries
1 C. water
1 C. sugar
Fresh limes
Sprite/lemon-lime seltzer water

Combine sugar & water in saucepan and boil 3-4 minutes to make simple sugar syrup. Blend syrup with strawberries (in batches) in blender. To serve, place 3-4 ice cubes in each glass. Add ½ cup of fruit syrup. Squeeze ¼ lime into glass and add the lime. Top glass off with sprite/seltzer water. Stir and serve.

*To do this with watermelon, substitute watermelon for strawberries. Add one packet of watermelon-cherry kool-aid flavoring.
