#### Recipe Corner



#### **Ingredients**

- 1 pkg regular golden Oreos, finely crushed {About 36 cookies}
- 6 Tbsp. butter, melted
- 1 pkg. {8 oz.} cream cheese, softened
- ¼ cup granulated sugar
- 2 Tbsp. cold milk
- 1 tub {12 oz.} Cool Whip, divided
- 2 pkgs. {3.4 oz.} instant vanilla pudding
- 3 & ¼ cups whole milk, cold
- 1 bag white chocolate chips

#### **Instructions**

- 1. In a large bowl, combine Oreos and butter and mix until crumbs are fully coated.
- 2. Press the crumbs into an ungreased 9x13 inch baking dish.
- 3. Place the pan in the refrigerator while you work on the additional layers.
- 4. In a medium bowl, mix the cream cheese until light and fluffy.
- 5. Add 2 Tbsp. milk and sugar and mix well.
- 6. Fold in 1 & ¼ cups Cool Whip.
- 7. Spread this mixture over the crust.
- 8. In another bowl, {sorry about all the dirty dishes!} combine the vanilla pudding with 3 & ¼ cups milk and whisk until pudding starts to thicken.
- 9. Spread the pudding mixture over the previous cream cheese layer.
- 10. Let the dessert rest for about 5 minutes so the pudding can firm up further.
- 11. Spread the remaining Cool Whip over the top.
- 12. Sprinkle the chocolate chips evenly over the top.
- 13. Place in the freezer for 1 hour or refrigerator for 4 hours before serving
