Recipe Corner ...

Easy Breakfast Casserole

6 Slices of Bread, broken into bite-size pieces

1 lb Sausage, cooked and drained

1 Cup Shredded Cheddar Cheese

6 Eggs

2 Cups of Milk

1 tsp. of Salt

¼ tsp. of Pepper

Heat oven to 350 degrees.

Place bread in 9 x 13-inch baking pan or casserole sprayed with non-stick cooking spray; top with sausage and cheese.

Beat eggs, milk, salt and pepper with whisk until well blended; pour over ingredients in pan.

Bake 25 to 30 minutes, or until casserole is set in center and top is lightly browned. Serve.
