Minister's Delight (From Taste of Home)

1 can (21) ounces cherry or apple pie filling 1 package yellow cake mix (regular size) ½ cup butter (or margarine), melted 1/3 cup chopped walnuts, optional

Place pie filling in a 1 ½ quart slow cooker. In a bowl, combine cake mix and butter (mixture will be crumbly); sprinkle over filling. Sprinkle with walnuts, if desired. Cover and cook on low for 2 to 3 hours. Serve warm, in bowls. Best if topped with ice-cream.

NOTE... For a sugar-free version you can substitute No-Sugar Added pie filling in place of the regular pie filling and a Pillsbury Sugar-Free yellow cake mix in place of the regular version.
