Ishmel Johnson-Bey will be our food vendor with his famous fish, tenderloins, hush puppies, fries and maybe sno cones.

Joyce reviewed for everyone all the donations of cash, door prizes, and goody bag items received thus far and said we will have a sponsors board naming all of them.

Publicity will be on three local radio stations, an article in The Republic, a flier on the screen at Yes Cinema, and on the Discover Columbus Website. Members have also dropped off our flier at many public businesses.

Frank Bayles reported that the dash plaques have been ordered at a cost of 90 cents each. Trophies have also been ordered at a cost of \$413.88.

Steve Weidner reported that he will get the games together but that he will need someone to work them.

We need everyone to come to the show to help set up and to work the various areas.

We need bake sale items and those items need to be things that won't melt in the heat.

We have obtained a City Permit for our Sign and Frank Bayles has obtained insurance coverage for the show.

There being no further business, Steve Weidner made a motion to adjourn and it was seconded by Marjorie Bott. The meeting was adjourned at 7:40 p.m.
