Wednesday, September 15, 2014

OLD BUSINESS

- Summer Slam Car Show update... 80 paid cars for show. Participant Complaints: Bikes and Dogs allowed at show. Participant Compliments: Great Food; Best organized show.
- Five new members joined the day of the show.
- Suggestions for next year: Get flyers out early for sponsorship; Use Facebook more often to make others aware of show; Check with other clubs to see what they do to increase attendance (Eddie w/ Southside would be a great contact for info); More help needed prior to show.
- Frank made a motion to keep the same date for the show (2nd Saturday in August). Rick Mackey seconded the motion.

- Rick Mackey suggested that we check into the cost and specifics of a Gaming License. We would then be able to have a 50/50 and raffles during the show. Frank will get the Tax ID number so Tammy can get information.
- Charities for the 2014 car show were Love Chapel and The Cheer Fund. Frank suggested we concentrate on one charity next year. Love Chapel is all volunteer and 100% stays in the county. He suggested the club discuss this and decide what to do for the 2015 show by the end of this year.
- A couple of members suggested that we might want to do a service project sometime during the year, possibly for the Habitat for Humanity organization.
- The Board thanked Dave Sell for the video at the last club meeting and for being the DJ at the car show. Tammy Barker was also recognized for all of the work and effort she puts into the Summer Slam car show.
- Somerset Car Show this coming weekend (September 23rd). An e-mail will be sent with details and meeting time and place for those wanting to attend.
- The former DJ had originally thought he would sell his sound system. He has changed his mind, but will continue to let the club use it for the car show
- Ritters closed early this season. They are unsure as to what they will do next year as far as re-opening. Frank picked up our wall plaque that was displayed there. Due to their situation we may have to decide on a new place for next year's cruise-in's. It was suggested that we check into the Fair Oaks Mall parking lot (near the former K-Mart store). Frank will check with the mall to see if we can use the parking lot. Tammy suggested we have vendors set up during the cruise-in's and possibly see if the Clarion would be interested in doing off-site catering there once a month.

- The Questionnaire was discussed. Several members feel that we should return to a restaurant for our monthly meetings. Frank will check with Sirloin Stockade and Golden Corral. The Sirloin Stockade originally wanted a guaranteed number of

people in order to use the room at no charge. It was suggested that we see if they will waive this requirement if we come on a night when they are usually slow.

Recipe Corner ...

Speedy Apple Butter (From Taste of Home)

2 cups unsweetened applesauce	¼ teaspoon ground allspice
¼ to ½ cup sugar	1/8 teaspoon ground ginger
1 teaspoon ground cinnamon	1/8 teaspoon ground cloves

1. In a small saucepan, combine all ingredients. Bring to a boil. Reduce heat; simmer uncovered, for 30-35 minutes, stirring every 3-4 minutes. Remove from the heat; cool. Store in airtight containers in the refrigerator. **Yield:** 1-1/2 cups.
