# **Zucchini Bread**

3 cups all-purpose flour 1 cup vegetable oil

1 teaspoon salt 2 \( \frac{1}{4} \) cups white sugar

1 teaspoon baking soda 3 teaspoons vanilla extract

1 teaspoon baking powder 2 cups grated zucchini

3 teaspoons ground cinnamon 1 cup chopped walnuts

3 eggs

**GREASE** and flour two 8 x 4 inch pans. Preheat oven to 325 degrees.

**SIFT** flour, salt, baking powder, soda and cinnamon together in a bowl.

**BEAT** eggs, oil, vanilla and sugar together in a large bowl. Add sifted ingredients to the creamed mixture and beat well. Stir in zucchini and nuts until well combined. Pour batter into prepared pans.

**BAKE** for 40 to 60 minutes, or until tester inserted in the center comes out clean. Cool in pan on rack for 20 minutes. Remove bread from pan and completely cool.
