
On the 19th the Make a Wish cruise in Greensburg raised \$2800 and for all the events they had going on that weekend they are expecting to have raised around \$4000.

BUCKEYES

Ingredients 1 ¹/₂ cups peanut butter 1 cup butter softened ¹/₂ teaspoon vanilla 6 cups confectioner's sugar 4 cups semisweet choc chips Directions

- 1. In a large bowl, mix together peanut butter, butter, vanilla and confectioner's sugar. The dough will look dry. Roll into 1 inch balls and place on a waxed paper-lined cookie sheet.
- 2. Press a toothpick into the top of each ball (to be used later as the handle for dipping) and chill in freezer until firm, about 30 minutes.
- 3. Melt choc chips in a double boiler or in a bowl set over a pan of barely simmering water. Stir frequently until smooth.
- 4. Dip frozen peanut butter balls in choc holding onto the toothpick. Leave a small portion of peanut butter showing at the top to make them look like Buckeyes. Put back on cookie sheet and refrigerate until serving.
