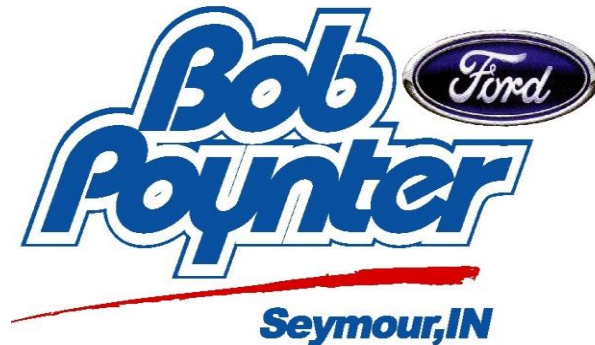

Recipe Corner

SUGAR-FREE STRAWBERRY PIE

1 ½ cups water

1 tablespoon cornstarch

1 small package strawberry flavored sugar free gelatin

4 teaspoons sugar substitute
3 cups sliced fresh strawberries
1 -9 inch graham cracker crust

Combine water and cornstarch in medium saucepan; stir well. Bring to boil, stirring constantly. Cook 1 minute. Remove from heat, and let cool slightly. Add gelatin and sugar substitute. Stir well. Gently stir in strawberries and pour into crust. Cover and chill at least 3 hours. Yield 8 servings
