Recipe Corner

Apple Peanut Butter Cookies – www.tasteofhome.com

- 1/2 cup shortening
- 1/2 cup chunky peanut butter
- 1/2 cup sugar
- 1/2 cup packed brown sugar
- 1 egg
- 1/2 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1 1/2 cups all-purpose flour
- 1/2 teaspoon baking soda
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- 1/2 cup grated peeled apple

Directions

In a large bowl, cream the shortening, peanut butter and sugars until light & fluffy. Beat in egg and vanilla. Combine the dry ingredients; gradually add to creamed mixture and mix well. Stir in apple.

Drop by rounded tablespoonfuls 2 inches apart onto greased baking sheet. Bake at 375 degrees for 10-12 minutes or until golden brown. Cool for 5 minutes before removing to wire racks. Yield: about two dozen.

NOTE: Reduced-fat peanut butter is not recommended for this recipe. If you prefer, dice the apple vs. grating.
