Now that Football Season is starting, how about trying some of these desserts for your tail-gating parties.

FIVE LAYER BARS



Ingredients

Five Layer Bar Mix:

•

- 1/2 cup chopped pecans
- 1 cup butterscotch morsels
- 1 cup shredded coconut
- 1 cup <u>semisweet chocolate</u> morsels
- 1 1/2 cups graham cracker crumbs

•

- 1 jar Five Layer Bar Mix
- 1/2 cup (1 stick) butter, melted
- 1 (14-ounce) can <u>sweetened condensed milk</u>

Directions

In a decorative jar, layer pecans, butterscotch morsels, coconut, and chocolate morsels. Spoon graham cracker crumbs into a small plastic or cellophane bag and place on top of the layers.

Preheat oven to 350 degrees F.

Remove <u>graham cracker</u> crumbs from jar. Combine graham cracker crumbs and melted butter. Press into bottom of a 9 by 13-inch baking dish. Sprinkle remaining ingredients of mix over crumb mixture. Pour sweetened condensed milk over the layers. Bake for 30 minutes. Allow to cool and cut into bars.
